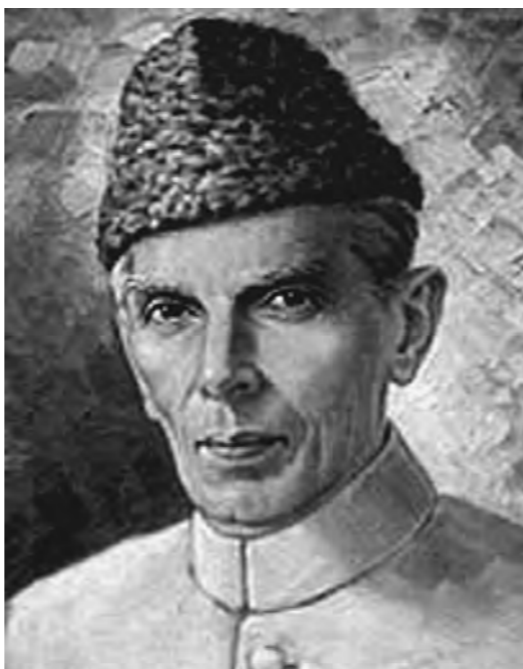

Since the establishment of diplomatic relations between Japan and Pakistan in 1952, the two countries have worked hard to build a warm relationship. As part of this, the Japanese business community established the JPBCC in 1984 in accordance with proposals made by the leaders of the two countries. Since that time, we have deepened contacts with a wide variety of parties involved in Pakistan's economic sphere and have held joint meetings aimed at facilitating the frank exchange of opinions and promoting trade and investment between our two countries.

Pakistan's continued efforts to improve its trade and investment environment will certainly lead to stronger economic ties and a closer partnership between our two countries.
