Art, music and lifestyle have not only played a crucial role in the Japanese interest for Italy, but they have also represented the emblematic cornerstones of the Japanese culture. As the ambassador of Italy in Tokyo, I must confess, also on behalf of my fellow Italians, that I am truly honored to represent Italy, the country we love, in Japan — a country that we also deeply love and respect.
