Bahrain, in common with most other nations, is affected by the coronavirus pandemic and has taken swift and decisive action to minimize the impact on its people and the business community. Bahrain has set up a dedicated National Taskforce to tackle the spread of the virus and took immediate measures to ensure that testing and quarantine facilities were set up without delay.

As part of the response, the government of Bahrain is supporting individuals and companies through a comprehensive \$11.4 billion economic stimulus package. The measures include extending Bahrain's liquidity fund initiative, interest rate reductions, loan restructuring and salary support, rent decreases and grants and utility relief for businesses.

What the current pandemic has done is catalyze a digital evolution that was already underway. The kingdom has been pursuing progressive new strategies that revolve around emerging technologies as part of its ongoing efforts to diversify its economy and reduce its dependence on oil. One great achievement of these strategies is the shifting of the entire functioning of the government to the cloud which has enabled


