The mutual official visits at the highest levels between our friendly countries have contributed to increasing the consensus of visions and convergence of views between the leaderships of the two countries on many bilateral and other issues of common interest. They also highlighted the need to advance bilateral relations toward achieving the common goals of progress, prosperity and the well-being of our friendly peoples.

In fact, the multifaceted cooperation currently existing between the State of Qatar

The pace of this promotion and development increased after Tamim's two successful visits that he paid to Japan in 2015 and 2019, which resulted in a wide range of agreements and memorandums of understandings that covered various sectors, including energy, infrastructure, education, health care, culture, tourism and more. The sheikh also attended the emperor's enthronement ceremony in October 2019, in a gesture that reflects the great importance that our country's top leadership attaches to Japan.

On the Japanese side, we refer to the important visit of then-Crown Prince Naruhito and then-Crown Princess to the State of Qatar in 1994, as well as the two important visits to the State of Qatar made by former Japanese Prime Minister H.E. In addition to the strong partnership that exists between the two countries in the field of LNG, relations have witnessed a qualitative leap in a wide range of fields outside the energy sector to include politics, security, trade, investment, innovation, technology, tourism, education and culture. At the political and security levels, there are regular high-level mechanisms for dialogue and consultation to discuss bilateral relations and issues of common interest. The first round of the bilateral political dialogue meeting at the level of the foreign ministers of the two countries was held in Doha in August 2021, in the presence of Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs of Qatar H.E. Sheikh Mohammed bin Abdulrahman Al-Thani and then-Minister for Foreign Affairs of Japan H.E. Toshimitsu

Motegi, during which a number of bilateral, regional and international issues were discussed.

Thanks to the constructive dialogue and mutual trust between our friendly countries, the bilateral cooperation and coordination on issues of common concern have been enhanced. We are working closely in many areas, such as resolving civil conflicts, promoting peace and providing humanitarian aid to developing countries. There is still great potential and a common political will to further enhance bilateral cooperation on important international issues.

In the framework of endeavors to consolidate a comprehensive strategic partnership, implementing the common vision of the leadership of our countries, the State of Qatar has been keen to strengthen and expand cultural and academic cooperation with our Japanese partners. Thanks to our joint cooperation and efforts, the first Japanese school was opened in Doha in 2009 as a means of nurturing generations that understand our cultures.

Efforts to enhance academic and cultural cooperation between educational and scientific research institutes and institutions in the State of Qatar and Japan continues. In May 2021, we celebrated the inauguration of the Chair of the State of Qatar for Islamic Area Studies at Waseda University, in implementation of the lofty directives of Tamim, and the project came as an extension of the cooperation that already exists between Waseda University and Qatar University within the framework of the twinning agreement signed between them.

Bilateral relations have gone beyond the official level to the popular dimension, as the understanding, communication and interaction between the peoples of our two countries deepened thanks to the many cultural activities that were held. The launch of direct flights to Japan by Qatar Airways in 2006 contributed to stimulating mutual trade and achieving remarkable growth in the number of Japanese tourists to the State of Qatar, and the number of Japanese community members in the State of Qatar has increased.

I would like to take this opportunity to extend an invitation to the friendly people of Japan to visit Qatar this year to enjoy the 2022 FIFA World Cup. We look forward to welcoming them in their "second country," — the State of Qatar.

We are confident that the celebration of the 50th anniversary of the establishment of relations between our two friendly countries will increase the momentum to reaffirm friendship, explore various areas of bilateral cooperation, and open new channels for exchanging experiences, developing skills and transferring advanced Japanese technology in all fields, as well as renewing the resolve to continue working to advance relations to higher levels toward consolidating our comprehensive strategic
