
Under the leadership of his majesty, the Sultanate of Oman announced the 2050 Net-Zero commitment and unveiled an ambitious green hydrogen strategy. The initiative envisions an estimated \$140 billion in investment in a new low-carbon energy industry. To lead this transition toward a green economy, the sultanate also formalized the establishment of a

new hydrogen-centric energy company, Hydrom, that will be the leading body undertaking the supervising and follow-up plans and programs for carbon neutrality. Oman is gearing up to be an important producer and exporter of green energy by capitalizing on its optimally suited natural resources, including solar and wind power, its attractive geostrategic location and abundance of land. In fact, 50,000 square kilometers have been initially allocated for projects related to green hydrogen.

In this regard, the Green Hydrogen Summit 2022 (https://greenhydrogensummitoman.com/) will be held from Dec. 5 to 7 under the patronage of the Omani Ministry of Energy and Minerals at the Oman Convention & Exhibition Centre in Muscat. This high-profile event will offer an unparalleled opportunity for international and Omani communities to come together, interact, connect and network to grow the potential of hydrogen energy systems for a more sustainable future, inviting decision-makers and energy industry stakeholders from all over the world. The summit will also be an excellent opportunity for organizations and industries in Japan to showcase their capabilities and expand their network internationally at an exhibition that will be held in parallel with the event.
