ful projects, including the new Dr. Antonio Agostinho Neto Angola International Airport and the Lobito Corridor project, which is the first strategic economic corridor that will allow the rehabilitation and extension of the Benguela Railway infrastructure. In the near future, it will connect the Atlantic and Indian Oceans by passing through Angola, the Democratic Republic of Congo, Zambia and Tanzania, improving African interconnectivity.

On the other hand, we are very enthusiastic about the rehabilitation work at the Port of Namibe involving the extension of the container terminal and the construction of the new quay bridge at the Sacomar Mining Terminal, a project financed by the Japan Bank for International Cooperation and executed by a consortium of Toyota Tsusho and Toa Corp.
