vate sector and prudently manage the natural resources while preserving and protecting the environment and continuing to promote human development through a comprehensive and integrated health care system.

The vision also aims at social development by taking into account justice, providing security and safety for all citizens and residents, and working on cultural enrichment and sports excellence.

Despite the conditions of the unjust blockade imposed on Qatar, the immunity of our economy from the external shocks has been strengthened. The World Bank expects Qatar's economic growth rate to reach 2.8 percent in 2018 and to rise to around 3 percent in the following years.

Our dependence on ourselves has grown, ties with our allies have become more established and our relations with most of the world have developed.

As economic diversification efforts

continue smoothly, the government gives the oil and gas sector, the source of our basic wealth, a special importance. Significant developments have taken place in this sector, by which Qatar will maintain its position as the world's largest liquefied natural gas exporter for many years to come. Our oil exports have not been affected by the embargo. Qatar has been keen to implement all its commitments under existing contracts and has concluded several long-term contracts with a number of countries during the embargo.

Diplomacy

On the diplomacy front, Qatar is keen to uphold the principles of respect for the sovereignty of states and the pursuit of good, neighborly policy and continues to be an active actor and supporter of all efforts to resolve differences, confront the challenges and dangers that surround the Arab and Islamic nations and

deal effectively with issues and problems that threaten international peace and security.

The bilateral relations between Qatar and Japan are traditionally strong, friendly and are steadily developing. The economic cooperation is the backbone of these relations, as Japan is one of Qatar's most important strategic partners in the field of energy. These relations continue to diversify and expand at a rapid pace to include the areas of nonenergy in efforts to transform them into a mutually beneficial strategic partnership.

The cooperation and coordination between the two countries have been strengthened through regular bilateral mechanisms at the economic, political, security and defense levels. Since 2006, we have been holding annual ministerial meetings of the Joint Economic Committee to discuss energy, trade, investment and other important sectors. The 12th meeting took place in October in Tokyo.

The two countries also hold high-level security and political dialogues on a regular basis to discuss bilateral relations and issues of mutual interest at the regional and international levels.

I am committed to working harder with our friends in Japan to strengthening the existing friendly relations and to achieve the desire, the political will and aspirations of leadership in both countries for promoting a future-oriented and comprehensive strategic partnership.

In closing, I wish to express my deepest appreciation to The Japan Times for giving me this opportunity to address its distinguished readers on this happy occasion and I would like to express my best wishes for all to have a very happy, peaceful and prosperous New Year.



The JQFA was established in 1976 with the aim of deepening friendship and goodwill between Qatar and Japan, as well as promoting economic cooperation and cultural exchanges. The association is currently active with 44 corporate members, and the position of honorary chairman of the association has been assumed by successive ambassadors of the State of Qatar to Japan. This year, the ambassador was replaced for the first time in about nine years.

Thereafter, I resolutely made it a goal to widely spread these memories to future generations.

Based on the relationship that has been built so far between our two nations, I believe that both Japan and Qatar will be

able to build deeper cooperative relationships as irreplaceable partners by deepening exchanges not only in the energy field, but also in the fields of education, culture, medicine, sports and others.

In particular, Qatar has moved to implement a plan for a large-scale increase in the production of liquefied natural gas. The country has also steadily constructed the stadiums, as well as the necessary infrastructure, to hold the 2022 FIFA World Cup. Therefore, Qatar has a potential to make a big leap forward in the future.

Welcoming His Excellency Hassan Mohammed Rafei Al-Emadi, the new ambassador to Japan, as the new honorary chairman of the JQFA, our association is willing to work closely with the Embassy of the State of Qatar in Japan and work hard to enhance further cooperation and make contributions toward Qatar's bright future.

In conclusion, I extend my most sincere congratulations for Qatar's continued prosperity and development under the great leadership of H.H. Sheikh Tamim, and hope that our relationship of mutual trust will continue to develop further.
