the lasting relations between Morocco and Japan, cemented by mutual respect and deep friendship between the Moroccan royal family and the Japanese imperial family. The novel corona-

virus has proven that international cooperation is vital to tackle the repercussions of the pandemic. In this respect, Morocco has implemented various solidarity actions, consisting of urgent medical aids that were airlifted to

July 6, the first fill-finish manufacturing project for COVID-19 vaccination in Africa was launched in Morocco, paving the way for the kingdom to become a leading pharmaceutical and biotechnology platform in Africa.

COVID-19 has also affected the global economy. In this regard, Morocco has launched an ambitious economic recovery plan, with a budget of \$13.5 billion, equivalent to 11% of the country's gross domestic product. Its cornerstone is the Mohammed VI Strategic Investment Fund, which is playing a leading role in fostering the national economy's capacities. This plan places Morocco at the forefront in terms of postcrisis economic recovery policy.

As for industry, Morocco has set a threeyear recovery plan starting this year that consists of three strategies: First, to confirm Morocco's industrial leadership by generating \$5.7 billion on the trade balance and creating 100,000 jobs. Second, to improve the country's competitiveness. Third, to position the country as a low-carbon industrial base.

With a plan to supply 1 million hectares of land for the benefit of investors, agriculture is also at the center of this recovery strategy. This plan is expected to generate an investment volume totaling \$4.3 billion, with an annual added value equivalent to two additional points of GDP.

In May, the kingdom launched a new development model - a road map bringing together political parties, institutions and civil society to set up the new strategic development goals of the nation toward 2035. This model is a new phase in consolidating the social and economic policies of Morocco.

The Moroccan approach to sustainable development places active solidarity at the center of its priorities, in order to strengthen social cohesion. Thus, Morocco launched in April the national plan for the generalization of social security to all Moroccans, including health insurance, pension plans and family allowances.

To conclude, I would like to commend the excellence of the relations between Morocco and Japan, which have witnessed a steadfast development on all levels. I am glad to note that over the past 10 years, the number of Japanese companies operating in Morocco has more than doubled, reaching 75 companies, making Morocco the secondlargest destination for Japanese companies in Africa. Furthermore, Japan is the largest foreign private employer in Morocco, generating more than 42,000 local jobs.
