On April 11, Talon was re-elected for a

second and last mandate with more focus on improving the life of the population.

First mandate: 2016-2021

During the first mandate, substantial reforms profoundly transformed Benin's economy. In 2019, Benin became a middle-income country with a per capita gross domestic product of \$1,250. Reforms in energy, basic infrastructure and agriculture have built a resilient and robust economy. In 2016, Benin generated none of its own energy, but by 2020, the country was able to produce 60% of its energy needs, while access to drinking water grew from 45% in 2016 to 70% in 2020. In the health care sector, reforms have resulted in the elimination of clandestine health centers. In addition, new high-tech hospitals were built to help,

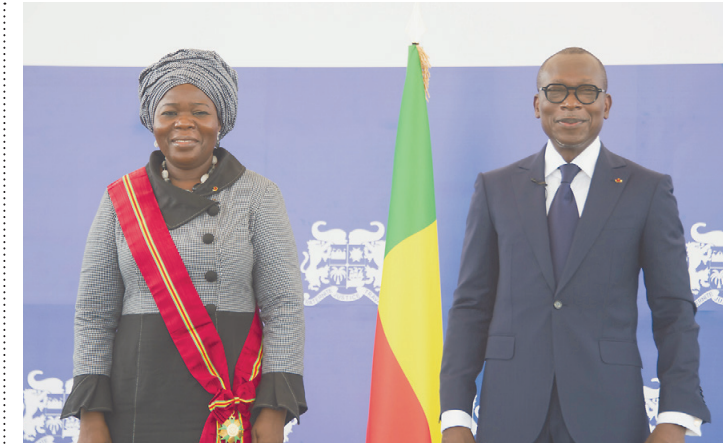
inter alia, fight the COVID-19 pandemic.

A healthier future (2021-2026)

By 2026, the government will build strong and sustainable health systems by making use of better infrastructure, data systems and devices that will help improve access to drinking water, electricity and clean energy, as well as help build our educational capacity (especially technical and vocational training for agriculture) to make the jump to digitalization, improve our food security and provide better access to mobile financial services for women.

Market opportunities

Benin is the gateway to West Africa, and it provides access to a regional market of 350 million people. As a regional hub for

tourism, services, and import and export, Benin presents an array of opportunities for any company interested in education and nutrition (via school canteens); health facilities and technical equipment; water treatment purification and irrigation; energy (solar power and mini-grids); agricultural technology and innovation;

and financial inclusion (banking and insurance).

Benin is open for business.
